VENUE AND DATES OF THE TOURNAMENT

Royal Colombo Golf Club Tuesday 23rd to Thursday 25th September 2025 Practice round on Monday 22nd September 2025

FORMAT OF PLAY

The Championship will be decided by stroke play, over 3 rounds of 18 holes each, subject to the Committee's right in the event of circumstances which makes playing of 54 holes impractical, to cancel any round or rounds at its discretion.

Division 1 - up to 20 handicap Division 2 - 21 - 30 handicap

The draw on the first two days will be done according to divisions. The draw on the last day will be done according to the aggregate gross scores returned over the first two days.

SCHEDULE OF PLAY

The schedule of play will be as follows:

- 1. Monday 22nd September 2025 Registration and Practice Round
- Players must leave the course by 4:00pm
- Rules Briefing 4:30pm
- Opening Ceremony followed by Tea 5:15pm
- 2. Tuesday 23rd September First Round
- 3. Wednesday 24th September Second Round
- 4. Thursday 25th November Final Round

ELIGIBILITY

Open to all Amateur Lady Golfers with a valid handicap of 30 and under in accordance with the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by the R&A Rules Limited. Certification of the player's current handicap indexes MUST be presented upon registration.

ENTRIES

- 1. All entries shall be subject to the approval of the Tournament Committee. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry without giving any reason.
- 2. Entries close: 19th September 2025. For international entries Entry form to be emailed to info@golfsrilanka.org. For local entries names should be entered in the file at local clubs or sent by email
- 3. Entry Fees: Locals Rs 5000/= for Sri Lanka Stroke Play and/or Sri Lanka Amateur Championship Ladies. International entries Rs.7000.

PRIZE GIVING

The prize giving will be held on Sunday 28th September 2025 at 6pm at the Royal Colombo Golf Club. All participants are invited.

EVENTS

- Sri Lanka Ladies Open Amateur Stroke Play Champion 2025 The winner shall be the player returning the lowest aggregate gross score over 54 holes. Prizes will be awarded to the winner and runner up
- The Nuwara Eliya Golf Club Challenge Trophy Presented by The Nuwara Eliya Golf Club. The winner shall be the player returning the lowest aggregate Nett score over 54 holes. Prizes will be awarded to the winner and runner up.
- Bronze Gross Prize Handicap 21 to 30 The winner shall be the player returning the lowest aggregate gross score over 54 holes prizes shall be awarded to the winner and runner up

DAILY PRIZES

Daily prizes will be awarded to the players returning the best Gross and Nett scores on each day.

The Winner and Runner Up of the above-board events will not be eligible to win daily prizes. A player is eligible to win only one daily prize (Gross or Nett) per day.

HOLE IN ONE

A prize will be awarded to any player getting a hole in one.

ADMINISTRATION

- A. The Sri Lanka Golf Union (SLG) shall be responsible for conducting the Championship and Handicap events.
- B. The SLG reserves the right to modify the Championship and Handicap Events in any way it deems necessary.
- C. Any objections or queries relating to the Tournament should be made in writing before 3pm on the day in question, to the Tournament Committee appointed by the SLG.

D. Any decision or decisions taken by the Tournament Committee of the SLG pertaining to the Tournament shall be final.

The Championship Committee's decision on all matters relating to this Championship is final.
