NOTICE

1. GENERAL

The Sri Lanka Junior Match Play Golf Championship 2025 shall be conducted strictly according to these rules.

2. ELIGIBILITY

The Championship is open to all Junior golfers (Boys/Girls) in all countries who have not reached their 19th birthday before the 1st day of the Championship (05th August 2025). For proof of age only a Birth Certificate issued by municipal authorities, National Identity Card or Passport will be acceptable.

3. FORMAT

The tournament will be played according to the age group categories (Divisions) listed below.

An 18-hole qualifying round will be played on 05th August 2025. The top 8 (1st to 8th position) qualifiers will play in the Championship Match Play event, the next 8 (09th to 16th position) will qualify for the Consolation match play event, the losing quarter finalists in the Championship and Consolation events will play a separate Plate Match Play event. Players finishing in 17th position onwards will play for 36-hole aggregate gross prize. The Tournament Committee has the right to modify a division and or an event in a method that is deemed fair for all players.

The draw will be done according to qualifying scores in the Championship and Consolation event. The 4 losing quarter finalists in the Championship and Consolation events will play in the Championship Plate and Consolation Plate events. ▪ Quarter finals on 06th August, Semi Finals on 07th August and 18-hole final on 08th August. Aggregate gross prize on 06th and 07th August 2025 ▪ Tee Markers Blue for Boys and Red for Girls ▪ Players from Silver, Bronze & Copper Division eligible to participate in the Open Category for Rukmini Kodagoda Trophy played separately for girls and boys, provided they enter for the Gold/Open Division only. ▪ If 8 entries are not received in the Girls Gold Division for WAGR, the option is available for any girl to compete with the boys. - Age group 13 – 14 yrs. plus (Under 15 years)
- Players should not have reached their 15th birthday before 05th August 2025
- Qualifying medal round of 18 holes to be played on 05th August 2025
- The 8 best gross scores (1st to 8th position) qualify for the Championship - Silver Division match play event. 9th to 16th position qualify for the Consolation - Silver Division Match Play event. 17th position onwards will qualify for two rounds of stroke play for the aggregate gross prize. The draw for the Championship and Consolation event will be done according to qualifying scores.
- The losing Quarter Finalists in the Championship - Silver Division and Consolation - Silver Division events will qualify for a match play Championship Plate Event Silver Division and Consolation Plate Event Silver Division.
- Quarter finals on 06th August, Semi Finals on 07th August and 18-hole final on 08th August. Aggregate gross prize on 06th and 07th August and Daily gross prize on the 07th August 2025.
- Tee Marker will be White for Boys and Pink for Girls.
- Players entered in this Division shall not be eligible for the Open Event or Gold Division
- Due to insufficient entries boys and girls will be amalgamated for the Consolation match play event. Boys and girls will play off separate tees as defined by the Tournament Committee.

For the Championship - Bronze Division and Consolation - Bronze Division, the draw will be done according to qualifying scores. ▪ The losing Quarter Finalists in the Championship - Silver Division and Consolation - Silver Division events will qualify for a match play Championship Plate event Silver Division and Consolation Plate event Silver Division. ▪ Quarter finals on 06th August, Semi Finals on 07th August and 18-hole final on 08th August.
